

# West Side wins state harrier run

## Central 2nd; Philpott first runner home

ELIZABETH — West Side High, surprise-winner of the Newark City and Essex County championships, added a state title to its laurels yesterday in the 32nd annual NJSIAA cross-country meet at Warinanco Park.

The Newark school placed its five scorers within the first 34 finishers for a low score of 80 points to capture honors in Division A, which embraces Group 4 and Catholic Class A schools.

Individual honors in this division went to Don Philpott of Montclair, Essex County individual titlist, who covered the two and a half mile course in 13:09.

### ABINGTON VICTOR

Lower Camden County Regional was the winner of the Division B title with 93 points. Fred Abington of Chatham, his school's only entrant, came home first in 13:00.8.

West Side had won the Division A title in 1949 and last year was tied for first place with Asbury Park. Regional now has won the Division B title two years in a row.

While Abington, who is better known for his feats on the soccer field, turned in the better time of the two individual winners, the Division A contest was much closer. Abington's margin over Tom Fekete of Regional was 100 yards at the finish, but Philpott emerged the winner in his division only after engaging Don Maltese of West Side and John Kopil of Bayonne's Sweeney High in a grueling charge over the last 440 yards.
