

South Side's Yee 1st, Plainfield repeats in Group 4 X-country

Plainfield High successfully defended its Group 4 team title and Bob Yee of Newark South Side won the individual run in the State Association's cross-country championships at Warinanco Park, Elizabeth, yesterday.

In other divisions, Wayne won the Group 3 title, Brick Township took the race for Group 2 and 1 schools, combined, and St. Aloysius of Jersey City prevailed in the Parochial class.

Plainfield scored 73 points to 75 for Vineland and thereby avenged its loss to the South Jersey team in last week's Seton Hall invitation meet.

12:49.2 FOR HYLAND

South Side's Yee turned in a 12:55 clocking as he defeated Essex County champion John Williams of Montclair.

However, the top individual performance of the day came from Davy Hyland of St. Peter's, New Brunswick, who won the race for Catholic schools in 12:49.2. Kevin Hennessey, who led St. Aloysius to the title with a 12:53.4 clocking in second place, also had a faster time than the other group winners.

Competition was keen in the parochial run, in which St. Aloysius nipped Holy Trinity of Westfield, 73-79, and in Group 3, in which Wayne edged Englewood, 141-145. Only Brick, in Groups 2-1, had it easy with a 53-69 decision over defending champion Mountain Lakes.

VASEY BEATS ANGEVINE

John Portee of Irvington Tech, state Group 3 mile champion, also was under 13 minutes in a 12:54.8 showing in the Group 3 run.

Two state mile champions, Dan Vasey of Highland Park (Group 2), and John Angevine of Glen Ridge (Group 1), battled it out in the Groups 2-1 run with Vasey scoring a 50-yard victory in 13:19.5 over the Ridger.
