

Cartier, Donovan get 1sts, Westfield wins x-country

Leading Westfield's runners in 13th place was Dave Gray. Tom Tinners placed 15th, Jim Brown 17th and Doug Merrick 23rd.

Raritan scored a close one in Group 3, edging Morris Hills, 136 to 145. Morris Hills placed Frank Fonseca third and Vic Brajer fourth. But Raritan had Warren Gordon sixth and Kevin Banks eighth, and made up the difference in the men who finished farther back.

Reinhardt and Tod Benson of Dover waged a close duel over the first lap of the Group 2 race. Then Reinhardt pulled away to win by more than 10 seconds. Kinnelon's team victory was aided by a fifth-place finish for Tom Stapler and a sixth-place run by Gary Cueman.

In Group 1, Bernards beat out Park Ridge, 94 to 118. Chuck Richardson was second, Bob Knauff 13th, Rich

Axtell 15th.

Bergen Catholic looked particularly strong when it beat out Essex Catholic for Parochial A honors, 63 to 72. Bill Mahon paced Bergen with a second-place finish. The Bergen Catholic scorers finished no poorer than 17th.

Queen of Peace picked up

its first cross-country state championship in Parochial B, outscoring Paramus Catholic, 34 to 81. The Riley brothers' tie-victory made the difference. They were to toss for the medal, but older brother Steve, a senior, took it. His brother, Gary, will get another chance next year.
