

TWO DEFENDING CHAMPS FAIL TO REPEAT

Bernards' Hallinan sets barrier for

Chris Hallinan of Bernards led the qualifiers in the NJSIAA sectional cross-country championships yesterday morning as he set a course record of 14:45 in the Central Jersey Group 1 race at Bueloch Park, New Brunswick.

At 16 sectional races, held at four sites around the state, the top five teams and the first 10 runners qualified for next Saturday's public school group championships at Pennsauken High School. No sectionals were held in the three Parochial divisions.

It was a bad day for defending state champions as Jerry Young of Franklin, the Group 3 defender, and Bob Sechl of Morris Hills, who won the Group 2 title at Montville last year, both failed to win their sectionals, though they did qualify.

Of the 1974 team champions, Bernards and Watchung Hills won sectional titles at Bueloch Park, but Princeton failed to qualify in Group 2 there, as did Parsippany Hills in Group 3 at the North Jersey 2 meet at Warnance Park.
